****Supplies are shared. No need to put your child's name on anything besides their headphones, scissors & folder.**

Please note: We ask for certain brands because we know they last the school year and this allows the students to be able to share when they are all the same brand :)

Student Supplies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bookbag - large enough to fit a folder, clothing, lunchbox, rest bag, etc. • 1 folder for daily "Take Home Folder" (we suggest a thicker plastic one, labeled outside with name) • Pack of Ticonderoga Laddie <u>QR</u> Beginner No. 2 Pencils (these are the thick/big pencils!) • 2 pack Crayola 24 count crayons • 1 pack of Crayola 10 count washable markers • 1 pair kids scissors • 6 Elmers glue sticks • 1 Elmers small School Glue bottle • 4 black dry erase markers • 1 package of Play-Doh (regular kind/size - please no foam or slime) • 1 pair of headphones labeled with name (over the ear - not earbud kind, not Bluetooth)
Classroom Supplies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 package of baby wipes • 2 boxes of tissues • 4 rolls of paper towel • 2 small bottle of hand soap • 3 containers of sanitizing wipes such as Clorox, etc. • 1 box Gallon zip bags (preferably ones with slider)
Other...	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One full change of clothes labeled in ziploc bag labeled (<u>to stay in bookbag</u>, shirt- long sleeve/short, bottoms-pants/shorts, 2-3 underwear, socks) • Jacket/sweater/sweatshirt in cooler months for classroom/playground wear • Water bottle labeled with student name for daily use

Lunch	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lunchbox if a student is buying. Label out & inside with first, last name
Rest Time Supplies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 drawstring bag labeled with first/last name on OUTSIDE of the bag • 1 small blanket • 1 small stuffed animal <p style="text-align: center;"><i>* Items must fit into the rest bag with ease. Must be a blanket in a bag not a sleeping bag. Students must be able to put it in him/herself, please practice this!</i></p>

Here are some examples of rest items we suggest:
