Legislative Update

H.B. 164

The House just concurred on H.B. 164 as amended by the Senate. This is great news! Now the bill will head to the Governor for his signature. The bill will be effective immediately upon the Governor signing.

The bill contains information that is very crucial to next year: School Funding, Teacher and Principal Evaluations, 3rd Grade Reading Guarantee, Home Schooling, etc.
