## Boros Twinkle Supply List (2023-2024)

- 2- bottle Elmer's glue (any size)
- 1- box resealable gallon bags
- 1- box resealable quart bags
- 4 -rolls paper towels
- 2- boxes tissues
- 2- packs baby wipes for messy fingers
- 2- 5-ounce boxes Dixie cups
- 2- containers Play-Doh
- 2- containers disinfectant wipes (cleaning purposes)
- 1-3 ring binder for home notes
- 2 class size snack items to share (Does not have to be individually wrapped)

# Clothing/Diapering

## Lunch

Lunch box clearly labeled with your child's name

Your child will need a lunch and drink each day. Lunch should not include foods that need refrigerated or microwaved.

### **Backpack**

Please label the backpack with your child's name

It should be large enough to hold your child's lunch, a three ring binder, art activities we may send home.
