If you, or a family you work with, have developmental concerns regarding a child residing within Geauga County, please refer to the following contact information. Parents will need to contact the school or agency based on the child's age and where the family resides. A screening can then be provided in the areas of communication, fine and gross motor, adaptive skills, social-emotional skills, and behaviors to determine if a disability is suspected. There is no cost associated with a screening. We encourage families to contact the appropriate agency as soon as they have a concern so interventions can be provided as early as possible.
