Together, we will partner to encourage and guide your child's learning.

Your child will be provided with a wealth of opportunities to grow in all developmental areas. The Twinkle staff provides a safe, caring, and nurturing environment meeting the individualized needs of your child. Our classroom is structured to support and encourage independence.

Each month we will send home a newsletter with tentative activities for that month. The activities are tentative based on the interests and direction the children take throughout their learning. Ianiro's Twinkle Supply List (2024-2025)

- 2- bottle Elmer's glue (any size)
- 1- box resealable gallon bags
- 1- box resealable quart bags
- 4 -rolls paper towels
- 2- boxes tissues
- 2- packs baby wipes for messy fingers
- 2- 5-ounce boxes Dixie cups
- 2- containers Play-Doh
- 2- containers disinfectant wipes (cleaning purposes)
- 1-3 ring binder for home notes

2 class size snack items to share (Does not have to be individually wrapped) Ex: Goldfish, popcorn, Cheese Its, granola bars, animal crackers, graham crackers, fruit snacks, etc.

Clothing/Diapering

2 packs baby wipes

1 pack pull-ups/diapers if your child is not toilet trained. **Pull-ups with sides that open are preferred**, so we do not have to undress your child, each time we change them. Thank you! 2 full changes of clothing, including socks and undergarments. These clothes will be kept at school. **Please label all of the clothing**.

Nap Items

1 blanket and/or small cuddly toy to be kept at school. We will send the items home each Friday, to be washed and returned. **Please label items**.

Lunch

Lunch box **clearly labeled** with your child's name Your child will need a lunch and drink each day. Lunch should not include foods that need refrigerated or microwaved.

Backpack

Please label the backpack with your child's name

It should be large enough to hold your child's lunch, a three ring binder and art activities we may send home.

Supplies may be brought to school during Open House or on the first day of school.
