Where we can grow would be creating additional events and opportunities that are innovative and enticing for participants to network, learn and collaborate in new ways.

Goal 3: School Representatives understanding available resources to support future employed citizens.



Rating Scale: 6

Comments: School partners attend meetings and speaking events to hear from the businesses the needs of future employees. School partners also take part in learning experiences such as Corporate Challenges and opening classroom doors to guest speakers to gain awareness. Planning for a summer Business Bootcamp for teachers is underway. Where we can grow would be to work with business leaders to share their facilities for school events.

Goal 4: BAC business members will host quarterly meetings.

Rating Scale: 8

Comments: All of our Lake BAC meetings are scheduled to take place at The Holden Center. Where we can grow would be to work with business members to alternate a hosting schedule.
