Purpose of the Course:

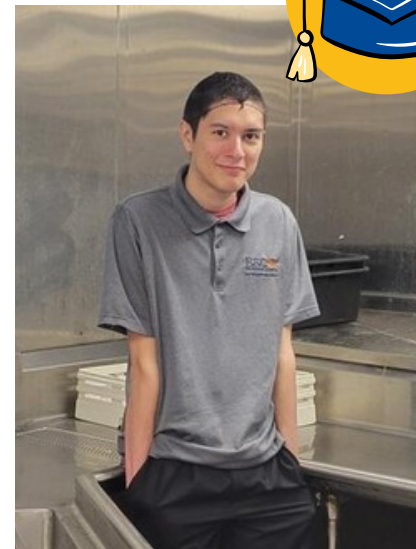
The purpose of the job training program is to provide a work environment where students can practice employability skills and learn job tasks in communities close to home.
