2. Superintendent Updates - Jennifer Felker

- Levy Outcomes:
 - Approximately 50% of levies passed (statewide: 40% new, 65% renewals).
 - ESCWR levy successful, schools may not be able to pursue a new levy in May.
- b. Challenges in Public Education:
 - Perceived declining value of public education
 - Impact of school choice policies on public schools.
- c. State Initiatives:
 - Emphasis on literacy and College Credit Plus (CCP) computer science.
 - Math Proficiency lagging behind literacy; potential for new math-focused mandates
 - Workforce development remains a priority.
- d. Special Education Needs:
 - Geauga DD no longer educating in-house; ESC facing educator shortages
 - Competitive pay needed for aids and teachers to meet increasing demand.
- e. Vocational Education (VO-ED):
 - 33 employees supporting VO-ED programs.
- f. Tutoring:
 - Grant-funded tutoring at Cardinal; exploring virtual tutoring options.



- 3. Guest Speaker Dr. Jack Cunningham, Superintendent, Cardinal Local Schools
 - Industry Partnerships (Middlefield):
 - Building stronger relationships between students and local industries beyond job fairs.
 - Example initiatives:
 - Lean Six Sigma: All Cardinal students graduate with at least a Yellow Belt.
 - STEM Training Lab: 7th-8th graders earning credentials in SolidWorks CAD and CNC.
 - ACE (Agriculture Career Education Academy): Independent from Cardinal but offers students pathways in agriculture (e.g., drone certifications, welding, internships).

4. Workforce Development Highlights:

- HC Companies: Paid 12-week internships.
- o STNA Program: Certification and paid clinicals for students aged 16+

5. BAC Seal Tracking:

- Schools must document and report OhioMeansJobs Seal hours for workforce activities (shadowing, internships, etc.).
- ESC to submit reports to the state; failure to report impacts district report cards.
- **6. LEC NeoSTEM Event for your students, March 10** For 10th 11th grade girls. Schools must provide busing.

7. Group Discussion:

- o Team Building:
 - Example from Great Lakes Cheese: Quarterly manager meetings, mental health initiatives, and partnerships with Ravenwood for on-site counseling.

Collaboration with ACE:

Pros and cons of partnering with independent programs like ACE.

8. Geauga Growth Partnership Updates:

- Focus on economic development and workforce programming since 2010.
- Current initiatives
 - Curating STEM panels and career awareness tours for schools.
 - Districts to arrange busing for participation
- **9. Tutoring**: Seeking businesses to provide staff as tutors; no teaching background required.



10. Celebrations:

- Auburn Update; \$4.2 million state funding for facility upgrades, including new spaces for exercise physiology and public safety programs. Open house in Spring 2025.
- West Geauga Achievements:
 - West Geauga Middle School ranked 7th in Ohio by U.S. News & World Report.
 - Elementary school ranked 17th in Ohio by U.S. News & World Report.

Jack Cunningham: Recognized strong district performance and efforts to retain students in Geauga County.
