The **SAIL** Program offers flexible services designed with each student's success in mind. A team of educational experts will assist your IEP team to identify the best placement for your student. An "Admission Rubric" will be utilized to identify the level of services that will be required for individual students. The **SAIL** team works with students, families, and IEP teams toward the student's long-term educational goals. Successful transition to the least restrictive environment is in the forefront of the goals for each student and the **SAIL** team will initiate the process when a student is ready. Our philosophy is student centered with an emphasis on successful transitions for every student.

The **SAIL** Program is designed for students on the Autism Spectrum who thrive best in a self-contained environment that emphasizes the acquisition of social and interpersonal language skills.

## PROGRAM DESCRIPTION



The **SAIL** Program is where children with Autism Spectrum Disorder have access to a structured educational program that has language acquisition and social skills as its cornerstone. A multidisciplinary team of professionals provide one on one and small group instruction using language rich and evidence based strategies. Students will benefit from structured academic teaching, social language groups, behavior management, functional living skills, sensory programming, social skills, and community experiences.



The **SAIL** staff is dedicated to providing a collaborative team approach to assist families in navigating all of the challenges and to celebrate all of the successes in raising a child with Autism.

Staff is involved in continuous professional development so students and families can receive the most current intervention strategies. They are also available to share their knowledge and share resources to families and community members.
