According to the GLSEN 2013 National School Climate Survey, 74.1 % of LGBT students reported verbal harassment due to their sexual orientation.

Lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender and queer (LGNTQ) students are also at greater risks for poor physical and mental health outcomes such as depression, substance use, self-harm, and suicide ideation compared to their heterosexual counterparts.

Teachers, counselors, social workers, and administrators are at the unique position to advocate for, and support LGBTQ students.
